Lakewood Elementary is a newer facility that was well-built and is well maintained. Most, if not all, educational needs of the staff, students and community are being met within the facility.

The site is adequately sized and has the amenities that are recommended and provides a safe traffic flow. On site parking is slightly less than recommended but does not seem to be an issue based on its current use/enrollment and could be addressed within the existing site boundaries.

Educational support spaces of teacher planning centers and student break out areas are not present and do not appear to be needed unless they become a district wide standard for educational facilities. The media center is centrally located and is slightly undersized for the student population. Cafeteria, kitchen and gymnasium space are adequate for the current student population.

This building is one of the District’s own examples of a modern educational space that meets today’s elementary needs. The building is nearly at capacity now. The site is large enough to allow expansion in the future if needed.
