Piedmont is a small two story elementary school on the outskirts of the district that, on the surface, meets most of the educational needs of the students and staff of the community. The classrooms, while not oversized, are acceptable in square footage for the students that are using them. The Media Center is undersized, but acceptable for the student population. Educational support areas such as student break-out areas and teacher planning centers are not available, but do not seem to be needed as it currently being used. Administration is located adjacent to the front entry.

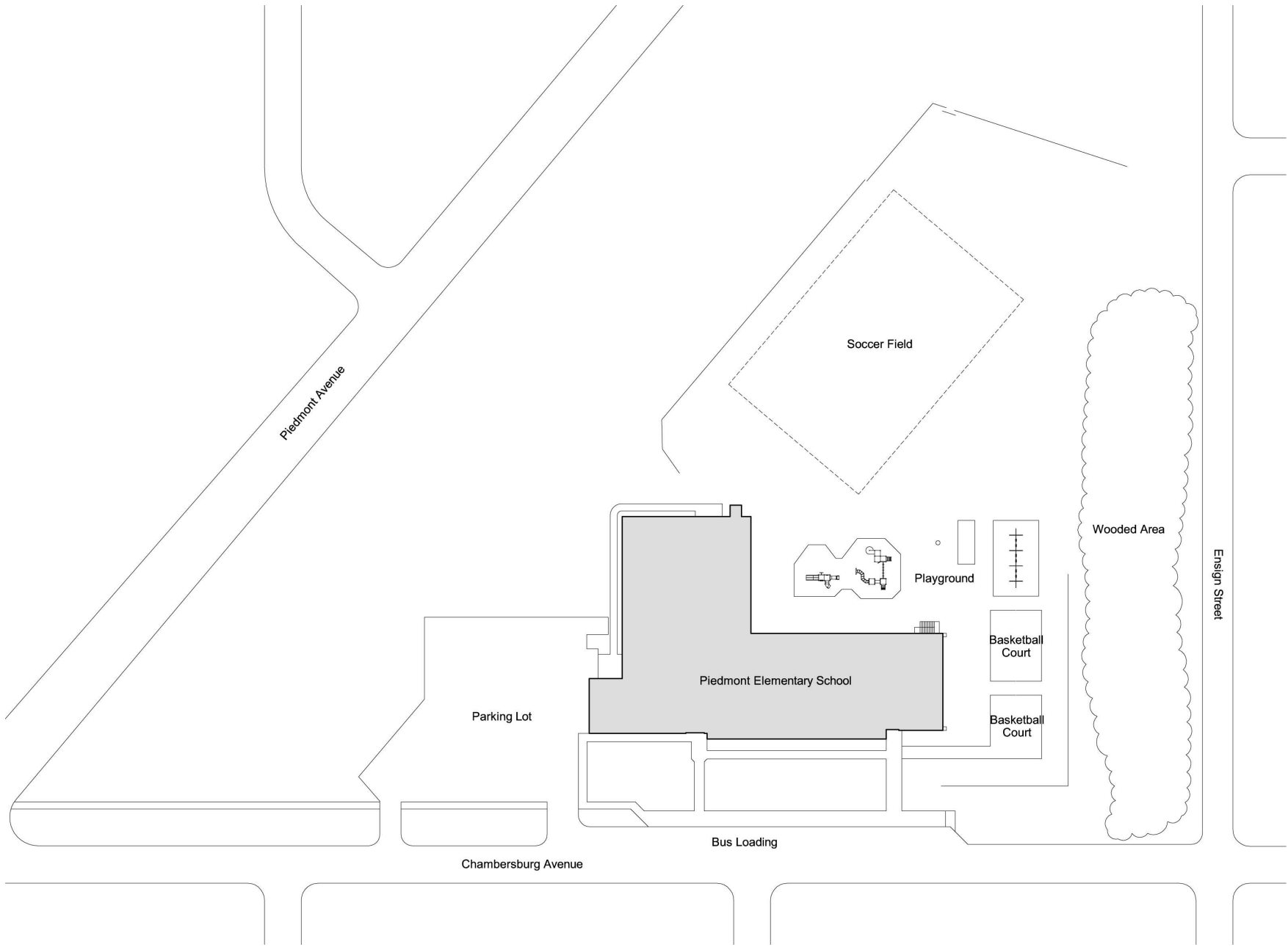
The site has enough room to accommodate the recommended separation and safety distances. Even though the site is large enough, it is not laid out to best meet these needs in its current configuration. Additionally, there should be more defined separation from the school site and the adjacent commercial areas.

The cafeteria dining area, with the serving and kitchen areas, is undersized and not appropriately equipped for the current student population.
