#1 Safety and Security

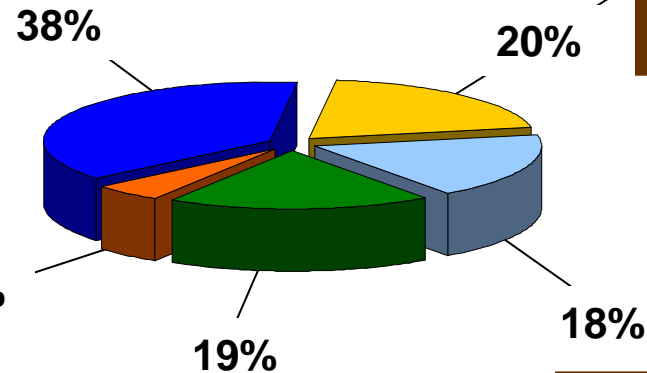
More than \$111 million goes for improvements in the safety and security of the buildings for our teachers and students.

#2 More Efficient Buildings

\$59 million will be used to make our schools more efficient. With heating costs rising fast, that makes sense (and dollars) in the future.

#5 Long Range Preservation

And the other \$14 million? There are other state and local building codes that we need to meet. And if we don't start painting the walls and repairing the cracks, soon we will be right back where we started.



#4 Replace Obsolete Schools

\$56 million is needed because state guidelines require school districts to rebuild any school when the repairs will cost at least 60% of the cost of a new school.

#3 Upgrade Our Facilities

\$53 million will make our classrooms and school facilities better places for students to learn, bringing 21st century education into Duluth's schools.
